Hi Everyone,

This is just a reminder that we cannot and will not cancel a swim meet when the weather forecast calls for less than optimum conditions. To do so, would be to forfeit the meet, and also, more often than not, it would be to make the wrong call.

The weather changes in Hampton Roads from thunderstorms to heat waves in minutes, so a meet can only be called right up to the time it should take place. In general, you should always plan that a meet will take place, unless you hear from the President or another Board Member that the meet has been cancelled.

This will usually be done via e-mail, or a notice will be posted on the website Home Page--or both. Sometimes we have had to do a sort of "calling tree" to get the word out last minute. This goes for Home Meets as well as Away Meets. We have to be at the pool, which ever one we are scheduled for at the appointed time, unless the meet was called prior to.

Again, if you do not receive an e-mail, or see something posted on the Home Page, plan on being at the pool for the meet.
