Parents, please remind your swimmers that at no time during a meet should they put any parts of their bodies in the pool, unless they are swimming. During relays this past meet, there were little ones sitting at the turn side of the pool, putting their legs, hands, and in a couple of instances pushing their friends toward the water. Another reminder for your swimmers—they are to go to one of their coaches after their events to get feedback as to how they swam. I know the coaches remind them of this before a meet, but in the excitement of it all, I'm sure it can be easy to forget.

Remember, all swimmers should plan on attending all meets—whether they are "A" or "B" meets. That is, unless they are not going to be here. In which case you should fill out an unavailability form, which can be found on the Forms page.

For those doing set up for upcoming Home Meets, please remember to print a copy of the pool diagram to take with you. If there's anything you noticed on the diagram that you think should be updated or isn't clear, please let me know. Your input to anything on the website is welcome!
